According to the ancient History Ayodhya was one of the holiest city where the religious faith of Hinduism, Buddhism, Jainism and Sufies (Islam) united together to build a place of enormous sacred importance. Ayodhya-Faizabad is known for its famous old temples and historic monuments. Faizabad has been an inspiration for countries' artists, architects, poets and politician over the years. There several places of interest around Ayodhya-Faizabad twins cities including Hanuman Garhi temple, KanakBhawan, DashrathMahal, Devkali Temple, Mani Parvat, SaryuGhat, GuptarGhat, Bharat Kund, MotiMahal, Tomb of BahuBegam, Tomb of Bannikhanam, Tomb of NawabShujaudaula (Gulab Bari) and Company Garden etc.

About the Theme

“The History of Sindh” is intertwined with the history of broader Indian Subcontinent and surrounding regions, Sindh was the centre of Indus Valley Civilization, one of the cradle of civilization, and currently a province of Modern-day Pakistan. Sindh has been known by the varies names in the past, the name Sindh comes from the Indo-Aryans whose legends claimed that the Indus River flowed from the mouth of a Lion. In Sanskrit the province was dubbed Sindh meaning as Ocean. The first known village settlements date as far back as 700BC, permanent settlements at Mehrgarh to the west expanded into Sindh. In Indus Valley Civilization and precursor, Meahrgarh other possibilities include a Dravidian identity. Concerning the Harappan Language in the case of Dravidian composition, further speculation within the Elamo-Dravidian Language hypothesis claims that Dravidian may have migrated from the Iranian Plateau and settled in the Indus Valley around 400BC. The Indus valley civilization spanned much of what is today Pakistan and North Western India, but suddenly went into declined just prior to the rise of Indo-Iranians. A branch of these tribes called the Indo-Aryans are believed to have founded the vadiccivilization that have existed between Saraswati river and Ganga river around 1500BC. This civilization helped shape subsequent cultures in the Indian subcontinents.
