About Conference

Dr R.M.L. Avadh University-Faizabad, is situated in the backward region of Uttar Pradesh. The students studying in this university belong to remote rural areas. This Conference would be based on descriptive analysis of various Socio-economic aspects of **Insecurity** in our economy as shown as below and be fruitful for students, academicians, researchers, policy makers, research scholars & entire economic society. The economy of India is the sixth largest in the world measured by nominal GDP and the third largest by purchasing power parity (PPP). The country is classified as a newly industrialised country, and one of the G-20 major economies, with an average growth rate of approximately 7% over the last two decades. With big demographic dividend long term, economic growth is positive. The International Monetary Fund (IMF) described the Indian economy as the "bright spot" in the global landscape even though growth is expected to have declined slightly to 7.1% for the 2016–17 fiscal years.

On deeply analysing we see that much of the growth in the economy since the 1990s has been due to the services sector covering communication services, hotels, restaurants, tourism, finance, insurance and real estate, including information technology where outsourcing work to India has become a global phenomenon. Growth of the primary and secondary sectors has not fared as well because of regulations and infrastructural constraint in these sectors. Agriculture sector once considered the backbone is suffering from crisis. On one hand is the rising economic growth story of the nation and on other hand we are lacking social security in all arena of life, starting from Livelihood, malnutrition, unemployment, violence of all type, terrorism, gender disparity, income divide between rich and poor, kidnapping and extortion, quality of public administration governance and states and central levels.

The socio-economic realities of our country differ significantly from the developed world. There is urgent need to have balance between economic development and social security

in society. Social security when made accessible to the vulnerable sections of the society uplift them in more than one way. It secures their health, employment, justice and dignity and all of this has an impact on the economy of the nation. There will be a gradual shift from quantity population to quality population. Thus, there is need to intervene at a policy level for restructuring socioeconomic development which can ensure social security and sustainability. 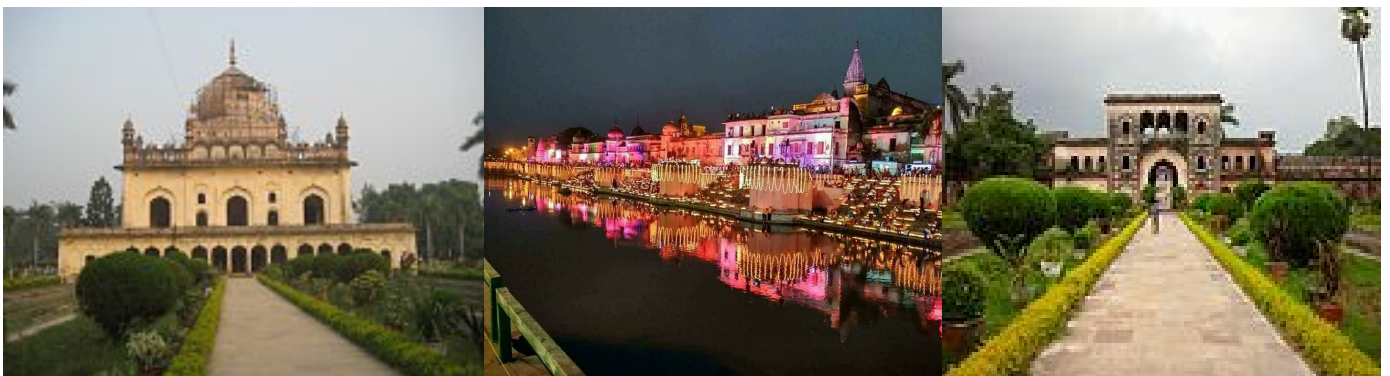

How to Reach Faizabad

Faizabad is on world tourist map. It is well connected by train and road transport with the rest of the country. There are direct train services to and from New Delhi, Ahemdabad, Agra, Jaipur, Dehradoon, Allahabad, Aligarh, Haridwar, Bhopal, Kolkata, Guwahati, Patna, Chennai, Mumbai, Kanpur, Gorakhpur, Lucknow and Varanasi. Nearest airport from Faizabad is Amousi airport, Lucknow, which is at a distance of 135 km.

Climate

Temperature usually ranges between 10° and 20° in the second week of December. It is advised to bring warm clothes with you. On the whole the weather is chilly pleasant in this season.

Arrival and Reception

Conference will be formally inaugurated in the morning of **11th December, 2017** at **University Auditorium at 10.00 a.m.** The delegates will be received at Faizabad railway station and bus station. To avoid inconveniences, the delegates should inform their arrival programme by e-mail.
