On the occasion of Lohia Jayanti, a special lecture on the theme "The Relevance of Dr. Lohia's Ideas" was organized at the Swami Vivekananda Auditorium of Dr. Ram Manohar Lohia Avadh University. ICSSR Approves Research on Ayodhya's Air Quality

Ayodhya, March 17, 2026. Dr. Vinod Kumar Chaudhary, Head of the Department of Environmental Science at Avadh University, has received provisional approval from the Indian Council of



Social Science Research (ICSSR), New Delhi, for a significant research project. Titled "Integrated Assessment of Ambient Air Quality and Health Risk Analysis in Ayodhya," this project has been sanctioned for a duration of 24 months, with a grant of ₹16 lakh approved for its execution. The objective of this research is to conduct a scientific study of the air quality in the city of Ayodhya and to assess its impact on public health. The study will involve an

analysis of pollution levels and their effects on the lives of the populace, following which remedial measures for pollution control will be proposed.

Dr. Chaudhary stated that this undertaking will be carried out under the guidance of the Vice-Chancellor, Colonel Dr. Bijendra Singh. He emphasized that, given the rapid development of Ayodhya, a study regarding air pollution and its health implications is of paramount importance—one that will prove invaluable to policymakers and the administrative authorities. International Achievement for Dr. Geetika Srivastava of Avadh University

Best Paper Award in AI Research, First Runner-Up in Coding Challenge

Ayodhya, March 18, 2026. Dr. Geetika Srivastava, Associate Professor in the Department of Physics and Electronics at Avadh University, Ayodhya, has achieved a remarkable feat in the field of Artificial Intelligence at an international conference held in Hakodate, Hokkaido, Japan.

In the "Multimodal Upper Limb Movement Intent Detection Challenge," organized as part of the "Activity and Behavior Control Challenge 2026," her team delivered an outstanding performance, securing the "Best Paper Award" and attaining the First Runner-up position in the coding category. For this achievement, the team was presented with a cash prize and a certificate.

Dr. Srivastava stated that this competition was organized jointly by the IEEE and the Machine Learning Group at Qatar University, with the participation of 157 research-

ers from 23 countries. The objective of this research is to develop advanced AI models capable of recognizing the movement of human limbs through the analysis of biological signals from the brain.



She further noted that this technology is expected to prove highly beneficial in fields such as prosthetics, rehabilitation robotics, and human-robot interfaces. Currently, research projects exceeding a value of ₹1.5 crore are being conducted under her leadership.
